

# HOW TO FIND YOUR RING SIZE

## PRINT THIS GUIDE

- 1 To obtain accurate measurements of the ring size you should choose, please download this PDF to your computer and print at a page size of 100 percent.
- 2 Prior to printing, verify the page scale setting by checking your printer's dialog box. Under the page scaling option, select "none" or uncheck the box for page scaling.
- 3 To ensure your printed document is the correct size, compare the guide provided to a ruler or quarter. The markings of the ruler should match precisely and the US quarter should completely fill the circle shape.



## MEASURE A RING YOU HAVE

- 1 Use a ring that fits you comfortably and has a similar band width to the one you would like to purchase. Place your ring on the circles below.
- 2 Match the circumference of your ring to the circle closest in size.
- 3 If your ring's circumference falls between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size.



## A NOTE ABOUT BAND WIDTH

All of our rings are available in full sizes. Generally, a band 1/4" or wider will require a size larger.
